Students will require:-

- Blue Polo t-shirt (with college logo)
- Black shorts
- White socks (ankle length socks - Sky-blue football socks)
- Trainers
- Blue reversible Rugby top (with college logo)
- Tracksuit top (strongly recommended)
- Football boots
- Tracksuit bottoms are permitted providing they are black or blue in colour.

This is the essential list. During the cold weather, lessons still take place outside so students will need warm outdoor clothing. The school tracksuit top is available for this purpose.

Sanctions

If a student fails to bring their kit

First Occasion	De-credit and automated e-mail home.
Second Occasion	De-credit and automated e-mail home
Third Occasion	De-credit, After-school detention and phone call home.

Students will have the opportunity to borrow suitable clean spare kit. Failure to borrow kit will be treated as failure to follow a reasonable request, resulting in referral to the supervision hall.

Injury and Medical concerns

If there is medical reasons for non-participation. Students are expected to bring a note and are **still** expected to bring appropriate kit. This will allow them to still participate in the learning **where possible**.

Health & Safety

All personal effects such as jewellery, religious artefacts, watches, hair slides, sensory aids etc should be removed by pupils before participating in physical activity.

If they cannot be removed, (e.g medical bracelet) protecting them with tape, padding or a wrist band can be used. Taping over ear studs, for instance may offer a measure of protection in some physical-activity situations. This would not be acceptable where close contact is foreseeable.

If the activity cannot be made safe the individual pupils concerned should not actively participate.

Long Hair worn by students should always be tied back with a suitably soft item to prevent entanglement in apparatus and to prevent it obscuring vision.

Footwear – trainers must be fit for purpose. It should demonstrate effective grip, support and reasonable protection for outside work and games. Pupils should never participate in socks on polished surfaces.

Personal belongings – Expensive belongings should not be brought into school. During lesson time changing rooms will be locked. Staff will not be expected to take personal responsibility for students valuables. Any valuables that are brought into school, are done so at the owners risk.
