Big Biology Day – 14th October 2017

Your son/daughter has been invited to attend the Big Biology Day event at Hills Road Sixth Form College in Cambridge. The event takes place on Saturday 14th of October from 10am to 3pm. The event is geared around promoting science in the community and caters to all ages and abilities. As a volunteer they would be required to be at Hills Road SFC by 9.30am for briefing. The activities for the day would be centred around showing young people how our hands work by creating a simple model consisting of paper, straws and string.

They would need to bring a packed lunch and some bottled water. Throughout the day there will be opportunities for students to take breaks and have a look around all the other exhibits and talks being given.

Travel can either be by means of the train to and from Cambridge station (NOT Cambridge North) or a lift from a responsible adult. Return train tickets cost approximately £7. I will also deliver them back to the station for the return to Ely between 3.30pm and 4.00pm. Please be on hand to collect them by approximately 4.30pm. If you would prefer to drive your son/daughter into Cambridge and drop them off at the college then please let me know so I can be on hand to meet them.
