Judo Club

Following a successful first term of Judo at Ely College we are delighted to announce that we will be continuing to run the club for the next term through until Christmas and into the new year, with a break in the final summer term. The club is open to both new and existing members, boys and girls, years 7 through to 11 and regardless of ability.

This is a really exciting new activity offered by the College and both the club lead Collin McCallum and myself have been extremely encouraged by the positive feedback received from students across the first 6 weeks and the level of engagement and aptitude demonstrated by the students.

The club provides students with the opportunity to develop their Judo skills for recreation, physical development or competitive purposes (hopefully representing the College at local, county or national level). Judo also has a strong record in helping to improve self-esteem, discipline and general mental wellbeing.

Ely College Judo club will continue to run from **Tuesday 31st October** and will run from **3.15pm to 4.15pm** in Needhams Gym for 6 weeks until **Tuesday 5th December**. Students will not need any specialist equipment and simply need to wear tracksuit bottoms and a t-shirt, and bring suitable refreshments for a demanding session. We are currently looking at possible funding to support the purchase of some Judo clothing for students.

A small donation of **£4 a session** will be required in order to cover the cost of coaching and equipment. In order to keep costs as low as possible we have subsidised the cost of these sessions as believe they offer a number of real positives to our students. In order to maintain continuity payment will be required in 6 week blocks (£24).
