Judo Club

Following a successful first 2 terms of Judo at Ely College we are delighted to announce that we will be continuing to run the club for the next term in 2018. The club is open to both new and existing members, boys and girls, years 7 through to 13 and regardless of ability.

As part of a new year promotion **anybody who starts in the new year and pays for the term will be given a free judo kit (£44 for 11 weeks)**. I am also trying to arrange a deal on judo licences to potentially save on registration fees for those wishing to compete.

This continues to be a really exciting opportunity offered by the college and both the club lead Collin McCallum and myself have been extremely encouraged by the positive feedback received from students across the first 12 weeks and the level of engagement and aptitude demonstrated by the students.

Ely College Judo club will continue to run from **Tuesday 9th January** and will run from **3.15pm to 4.15pm** in Needham's Hall for 11 weeks until **Tuesday 27th March**. Students will not need any specialist equipment and simply need to wear tracksuit bottoms and a t-shirt, alongside bringing suitable refreshments for a demanding session.

A small donation of **£4 a session** will be required in order to cover the cost of coaching and equipment. In order to keep costs as low as possible we have subsidised the cost of these sessions as believe they offer a number of real positives to our students. In order to maintain continuity payment will be required in 5 week blocks (£20) or a 11-week block (£44) in order to receive a free Judo kit.
