One of the many initiatives running at Ely College to assist our students in their pursuit of the best possible grade when they take their GCSEs is the weekly maths clinic. This runs on a Thursday immediately after school between 3pm and 4pm and is open to ANY student from ANY year group.

The clinic is always staffed by a member of the maths department along with the support of one of the teaching assistants who regularly operates in the maths department.

The sessions are free to attend and for any length of time. They are designed as a drop-in so that students can bring a piece of homework that they need help with, or they can attend if there has been something in a maths lesson that they have not fully understood or that they need extra practice exercises to fully embed the learning that has been taking place.

As the students are all now in secondary school they are expected to take more responsibility for their learning and one aspect of this is to seek support when they feel the need. We are more than happy to help any student and hope to see more pupils in attendance in the coming weeks and months.
