### What will I do on the Taster Day?

You should make your own way to arrive at Bishop Laney by 9.45am, though you are welcome from 9:00am. At registration you will receive a map and your programme for the day. You don't need to wear school uniform.

After a short welcome talk, you will be able to try out four different subjects, have a look around the Sixth Form and meet some of our current students who can tell you what it's like to study here.

You'll try out 4 courses, with a break in between and followed by a free lunch where you can meet our current students. The day can then end at 2.15pm, or if you are interested in the Norwich Football Development Programme there is an opportunity to meet with the team and take part in a training session from 2.15pm finishing by 3:30pm.

We will be running a shuttle bus from Ely Station to the College from 9.15am and returning at 2.25pm and 3.45pm.
