## Year 11 – Final Arrangements

Year 11 have continued to impress us with their conduct and focus during examinations and their hard work in lessons this week. Just a reminder that Year 11 students only need to be in college for their exams from Monday 11<sup>th</sup> June. Should they wish to be in college to study, they may do so in the LRC.

We would like to confirm arrangements for the leavers' assembly on Friday 15<sup>th</sup> June. Students will meet in the Dining Hall after their Physics exam. The finish time will vary between 10:15 and 11:15 and so we will hold students together. Students will be able to sign each other's leavers' books that many of them have begun. There will also be an opportunity for them to buy prom tickets (priced at £13) if they have not already done so. The Dining Hall will be serving food as normal at break time and then Year 11 will head into the Dining Hall at 11:15.

Uniform – We would like to ask Year 11 parents to kindly consider donating unwanted blazers and ties on Friday 15<sup>th</sup> June. We would use these as spares or assist families in hardship. For remaining exams students should wear; white shirts and regular school trousers/skirts/shoes please. A standard jumper or sweatshirt will be acceptable as well, if required. If students wish to retain their blazers through to the end of the exams, they may, and then hand them into any house office or main reception.

If students still have library books or other books that they need to return, Friday 15<sup>th</sup> June would be a good date to do so. In addition, if they have books that they have bought and no longer require, such as the History revision books, we would be grateful for any of these so that they can be used with other students who may not be able to purchase them. There will be a table for the collection of these in the Dining Hall.

The highest standard of behaviour will be expected on this date. We expect that some students may be excited, emotional or pleased to be finishing their exams, but we would like to remind them that not all Year 11 students will have finished their exams and that they should continue to adhere to normal college conduct and expectations. Should this not occur, students will be asked to leave and forfeit their place at the prom.

Staff at the college are really looking forward to celebrating with students at their prom on 29<sup>th</sup> June at The Maltings. We are lucky to have such a wonderful venue where parents and the community can share the arrivals with us. We are expecting students' behaviour to be exemplary and will call parents to collect children from The Maltings should this not be the case.
