The Norwich City FC Regional Development Programme for Cambridgeshire, is delighted to announce its brand new Girls College Football Programme supporting Post 16 Education and allow female participants between the ages of 16-18 to continue their education and career development through Study and Football.

This high quality experience will allow students to study a variety of vocational courses with a designated tutor at Bishop Laney Sixth Form College in Ely & Soham Village College over a 2 year period, and the opportunity to train with qualified UEFA Qualified coaches whilst representing Norwich City Football Club in the Female English Colleges Fixture Programme.

The programme will also include weekly internal fixtures against other Norwich City FC College Schemes in Norfolk, as well as residential trips, opportunities to watch a variety of Norwich City FC fixtures, full Norwich City FC training wear *(registration cost) and Career progression/opportunities.

Fourteen College Football places will be awarded at Bishop Laney Sixth Form. Potential Candidates will need to secure 5 A-C Grades, including Maths & English. Students enrolled on the course will also look to gain their FA Coaching badges with us.

The programme allows for girls to continue to play with their Clubs but also if girls excel we can provide exit routes into Norwich City Ladies FC, Cambridge United Women, Cambridge City Ladies & St Ives Town to name a few.

The programme also allows for students to progress to University, US Scholarships and careers in coaching and the sports industry.
