Mix each layer separately and assemble in lined tin until set, scrumptious.


Create a document to advise everyone using the salon, the safety recautions you think they should be taking. Base your advice on the Hair r Beauty Salon at college. This sounds like a competition.

Dermatitis - Create a poster to inform stylists and therapists of the measures they can take, to prevent getting Dermatitis




