Yr 7 Bikeability Training

At the end of the Autumn term 2020 we advised Yr 7 parents and carers we had secured a two-week slot of Bikeability Level 2 training for students in Yr 7 who missed out during their final terms at primary school. I'm now pleased to be able to share further details.

In order to achieve the Level 2 training, each child is required to undertake 2 hours of training per day, over 4 days. This training will be delivered by an experienced team from Cambridgeshire County Council. They will be on site here at Ely College during weeks commencing: 10th May 2021 and 17th May 2021 (assuming we are not in lockdown). Training sessions will be delivered during the usual school day and students who have signed up will miss timetabled lessons for the daily 2 hour session. The training sessions take place initially on our playground, and then on nearby roads. Parents/Carers are responsible for ensuring students have their bicycle and equipment at college in readiness for Bikeability training.

This opportunity is available for up to 112 children in Yr 7. Places will be offered on a first come, first served basis.
