### **Arrangements for Year 11 Leaving Celebration**

As usual, during the last day of this half term, Friday 28 May, we will be giving year 11 students the opportunity to celebrate their time at the college and to mark the last occasion when they will all be together before the full exam programme begins after half term.

There is a science exam for some students first thing on Friday. This will be over by 10.00 a.m. so at 10.30 a.m. all the students will go over to the sports hall where there will be an opportunity to sign shirts, leavers' books and take group photographs. We will also have a professional photographer on hand to take group photos as requested, but also to take a whole year photograph. For this, all the students will need to ensure they have a standard black sweatshirt. This will be followed by a final assembly in the hall during which awards will be made. Students will then leave at 12.45. Buses have been arranged for this time for those students who would normally use them.

After half term, normal timetable for year 11 is suspended. There is, however, a programme of revision classes for each examination, usually the day or morning before, and this will be issued this week. Students are expected to attend these classes unless they have an examination at that time. An examination timetable has already been issued . Morning examinations start at 9.00 a.m. and afternoon examinations start at 1.00 p.m. Students need to be at the examination room at least 15 minutes before the exam is due to start. Those students in College for an afternoon examination may use the canteen for sandwiches from 12.30. For those who qualify, these will be available as free school meals
