Seminar - The path to diagnosis

In general, before any child or young person can be diagnosed with a special educational need or disability, the local authority and health services have agreed processes, sometime called pathways, to be followed. This means that only cases where there is a demonstrated need are referred to health, so that waiting times remain as low as possible. It also ensures that whoever is doing the assessment has all the information they need to make their decisions. This seminar will explain the processes for the main types of SEND.

OR

Seminar - Annual Reviews of Education, Health and Care Plans (EHCP)

We all have worries about how our children will manage as adults. This session allows you to explore this with other parents/carers and looks at how you and schools can help your child start to develop skills that will help with independence from an early age. Includes information about relevant support as your child gets older.

5 MINUTE BREAK - to change seminars

Seminar - Discussing with your child their diagnosis

Discussing with your son or daughter their diagnosis can be difficult. It needs to be positive and recognise what they can do but at the same time help them understand when they may need help. How you do this needs to change with their age. This session will give you some advice

and allow you to discuss your individual concerns about how to do this with your son or daughter.

OR

Seminar - How schools support pupils with Special Educational Needs/Disabilities (SEND)

Schools can support the majority of pupils with special educational needs and disabilities without the need for an Education, Health and Care Plan (EHCP). This seminar will explain how they do this and the law and guidance they follow when they do so.
