The year 10 science mock exams will begin after the Easter break. Each student will sit 3 exams: Biology, Chemistry and Physics. These exams will run during lesson time and be split to ensure that all students are given their allocated exam time.

The results of these exams will be used to plan the remaining time in your child's GCSE science course. Students will be reset based on the results and students may be moved from separate to combined (or combined to separate) based on their progress so far.

All students have access to Educake, an online learning platform that students can use to set their own revision questions. The questions are self-marking and provide students with instant feedback on their progress. Please email teachers if your son/daughter has forgotten their username.

All students also have access to Seneca learning, another online learning platform that is a revision guide and also includes questions.

All year 10 students are encouraged to attend science revision Session 6's. These run Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays after school (week A and B). Please note that students do not need to attend the session run by their teacher.
