



## Ely College Meningitis ACWY and Tetanus, Diphtheria & Polio Vaccinations Year 9's

Please be aware that if your child has received their 1<sup>st</sup> HPV vaccination we will offer their 2<sup>nd</sup> and final dose on the same day as the MenACWY/DTP vaccination unless they have previously received their 2<sup>nd</sup> dose

Dear Parents/Carers

The Meningitis ACWY and Tetanus, Diphtheria and Polio vaccines are available to all year 9 students in school and are free on the NHS.

The MenACWY vaccine helps protect older teenagers and young adults from getting <u>meningitis</u> (inflammation of the lining of the brain) and <u>septicaemia</u> (blood poisoning). Tetanus, Diphtheria and Polio are serious diseases that can affect the nervous system, breathing and heart.

If you do not submit a consent form, we will contact you in order to confirm that you do not wish your child to receive the vaccine.
