Yr 7 Ukulele Group

I am writing to you to share details of an exciting opportunity for your son/daughter to take part in a session 6 extra-curricular provision offered by the Music department during the final half-term: the Yr 7 ukulele group.

Yr 7 ukulele group will take place on a Thursday (Week A and Week B) from Thursday 10th June, between 15:00 to 15:40, until the end of term. The rehearsal will take place in LG2, which is allocated to this specific year group during the same curriculum day, so your son or daughter will be using an appropriate space that follow the college's risk management policies. As with normal music curriculum lessons, your son or daughter will be asked to use sanitiser on entrance/exit of their classroom, and they will be asked to leave their bags on the storage racks provided outside of the classroom.

LG2 is a large room, that is a well-ventilated space. The decision has been made to cap participants to 20 students to enable safe social distancing within the classroom. Students will be separated and asked to stand in an appropriately distanced formation around the edge of the classroom. Students have been asked to sign-up with myself via a Microsoft Forms document on their Teams class page in advance of the rehearsal, and an accurate register will be kept monitoring attendance and participation.

As ukulele group will be taking place at the end of the school day, alternative travel arrangements will be required for students to make their way home. At the end of the rehearsal, your son or daughter will be walked around the main school site and will exit through the main car park outside front reception.

Thank you for your support and encouragement to get your son/daughter involved in the Music department's session 6 provision, and I look forward to sharing the product of their musical participation with you in the near future.
