Dear Parent/Carers

As you are aware Ely College is a member of Cambridge Meridian Academies Trust. Each year the Trust organises a week of cultural, sporting and academic activities for students across the Trust.

This year we would very much like to make these face to face events where students across the Trust meet and work collaboratively, in their school ‘bubbles’, on exciting packages of learning and/or competing. We are mindful, however, that this will be contingent upon Coronavirus restrictions, both local and national, and have written a thorough risk assessment for each event. Although we are planning for this to be face to face, we have also organised a set of virtual activities should meeting up in person not be possible.

The Director of Physical Education for CMAT schools has therefore organised activities for a group of Year 7-10 students from our school. These will be held at St Ives Leisure Centre on 30th June 2021 and the exciting news is that your child has been chosen to be a part of our school team.

Organisation

Your child will attend school at the normal time and travel St Ives Leisure Centre by coach. **Students will require a packed lunch and plenty of water** and activities will start at approximately 9.30am, concluding approximately at 2.30pm, where they will travel back to school arriving, we estimate, at approximately 3.30pm.

The Covid risk assessment for this activity means that we will have to take mitigation measures and that will mean we will be asking students to wear face masks when travelling.

The day’s activities are designed to encourage students to develop key skills like competition, team work and cooperation to provide an enjoyable day where students have the opportunity to represent their school and see how it can be of benefit for their future and to broaden their perspective on the wider world. 
