Yr Mock Exams

In the week commencing 15th November, for 2 weeks, Year 11 students will be sitting a round of mock examinations. These will form a large part of the evidence base, although other work will be taken into consideration, for the forecasts that will be reported to Sixth Form colleges as part of the Post 16 application process. Whilst the mocks are important, they aren't the final GCSEs and so students should prepare for them but still bear in mind there is a long way to go until May 2022.

To help students prepare and plan their revision please find attached a copy of the mock timetable and a document that gives an overview of what is contained in each of the papers. Also, on the document is the equipment that we would expect students to arrive with. As part of college risk mitigations for COVID we are wanting to minimise equipment that is used by multiple students and so on this occasion students will be asked to wear a face covering for the duration of each paper.
