## **Blood Brothers – 10<sup>th</sup> February 2022**

Following on from my initial correspondence regarding the theatre visit to the New Wimbledon Theatre, I am writing to advise you of the final trip arrangements and am detailing below the venue's Covid advice.

Theatre venues are no longer requesting to see negative LFTs, or an NHS Covid pass for under 18-year-olds but do ask us to respect the following:

- **Attendees under the age of 18 must provide verbal confirmation that they have not tested positive nor are currently suffering from symptoms of COVID-19 from their parent, guardian or the individual themselves if they are aged 16 or 17.**
- **The theatre encourages and recommend all audience members aged 11+ to continue to wear masks throughout their visit to the Theatre.**
- **The cloakroom has limited space for school items, so it is recommended that bags are left at school or on the coach except for first aid kits/medical supplies carried by staff.**

We will be leaving college at 10.15am. We ask that the students meet me and the accompanying staff members: Mrs Jolly, Mrs Constable and Mr Agboke at the coach departure area, outside Scott House at 10.10am. Your child will need to bring a lunch and supper for this trip and additional refreshments/water or/and spending money for snacks from the theatre.

The running time of Blood Brothers is 2 hours 45 minutes, with an interval - it is estimated that we will be back at college by 9.00pm the latest. Please can parents arrive promptly from 8.50pm, at the layby by Needham's gate.
