Year 11 Updates

We are offering Year 11 students the chance to purchase a Leavers' Hoodie as a memento of their last year at Ely College. We are unable to accept late orders due to the printing schedule.

We would like to make you aware that Year 11 will have a year group photograph taken on Thursday 31st March. Each child will be photographed individually and then be superimposed onto a background. This keeps time out of lessons to a minimum. Details on how to purchase and the cost of the photograph will follow in due course. Usual school rules on makeup, jewellery and uniform apply!
