Friday 10<sup>th</sup> June is the final day of normal lessons and so from Monday 13<sup>th</sup> June, students are required to attend college for just their master classes and exams. Should students wish to come in at other times to study, please contact me directly and we can make plans to do so in the LRC. Thursday 23<sup>rd</sup> June is the last exam for Year 11 and we look forward to celebrating this with students on Friday 24<sup>th</sup> June from 7pm at the Prom. Tickets are £16 and can be bought via WisePay until 20<sup>th</sup> June. We will continue to remind students that the exemplary conduct displayed so far should continue to ensure entry to the Prom. This will include departure from college on both Friday 10<sup>th</sup> June and Thursday 23<sup>rd</sup> June when usual behaviour and uniform expectations will apply as the rest of the college operates as usual.

The awarding bodies have designated Wednesday 29<sup>th</sup> June as a contingency day. This means that should an exam have to be rescheduled due to disruption or unforeseen circumstances, then it will occur on this day.
