## Tuesday 18th July – In college 'meet the tutor' event 3:45pm -5:15pm

Each family will be given a specific time when they can come into college and meet their child's form tutor. Invites will be sent out closer to the event.

### Uniform

For September your child will need to be wearing the college uniform. This includes a grey jacket, black trousers or skirt, white shirt and House tie.
