Our Year 11 students have now reached the year which marks the end of their secondary education. It is a time when important decisions about the future have to be made and all young people will be required to stay in education or training until their 18<sup>th</sup> birthday.


We would like to invite you to a **Post-16 Progression Evening** in the Assembly Hall and Dining Room at the college on **Monday 2<sup>nd</sup> October 2023**. The purpose of this evening is to give you information on the opportunities available to students when they leave school and the range of courses available to them in Post-16 Education. Information about how to apply for this provision will be shared during the evening so it is important that you attend. Students will be supported through this process in both assemblies and PSHE lessons.
