Platinum PLEDGES Award



Welcome to our Platinum PLEDGES Award, an extension of our PLEDGES award.

To attain the Platinum PLEDGES Award, you must complete three PLEDGES ambassadorial activities, outside of school, that demonstrate a continued and significant commitment to our PLEDGES values. Upon completion of each ambassadorial activity, you will be awarded a PLEDGES ambassadorial shield. Examples of activities that qualify for a PLEDGES ambassadorial shield are included within the following pages. Once all three ambassadorial activities are successfully completed, you'll receive your Platinum PLEDGES Award.

Before you start an ambassadorial activity, you must present your proposal to your Senior Tutor, Mr Fisher or Mr Grezio. This will ensure it meets the values and rigour of the award.

You will need to provide evidence of your ambassadorial role. This will be a combination of photographic, video, PowerPoint presentation or written overseer appraisal. Electronic evidence must be emailed to the member of staff who approved your proposal.



Activity focus: Participation and Leadership

Minimum 6 sessions

Contribute to the wellbeing and development of others.

You could:

- Lead an activity such as coaching or skill building in sport, art or music
- Mentor, train or lead an activity in an organisation such as scouts, guides or air cadets.

Minimum 5 hours

Engage in a sustained activity that expands your understanding of people groups outside of your typical experience.

You could:

- Organise a cultural exchange with an overseas contemporary.
- Visit 3 or more places of cultural or religious significance or attend services from different faith groups. In both cases compile a video diary or presentation for school.
- Set up and run a group that promotes inclusivity for 6 weeks or more.
- Work with local organisations such as foodbank or the Lighthouse Community Centre to help others in our community.
