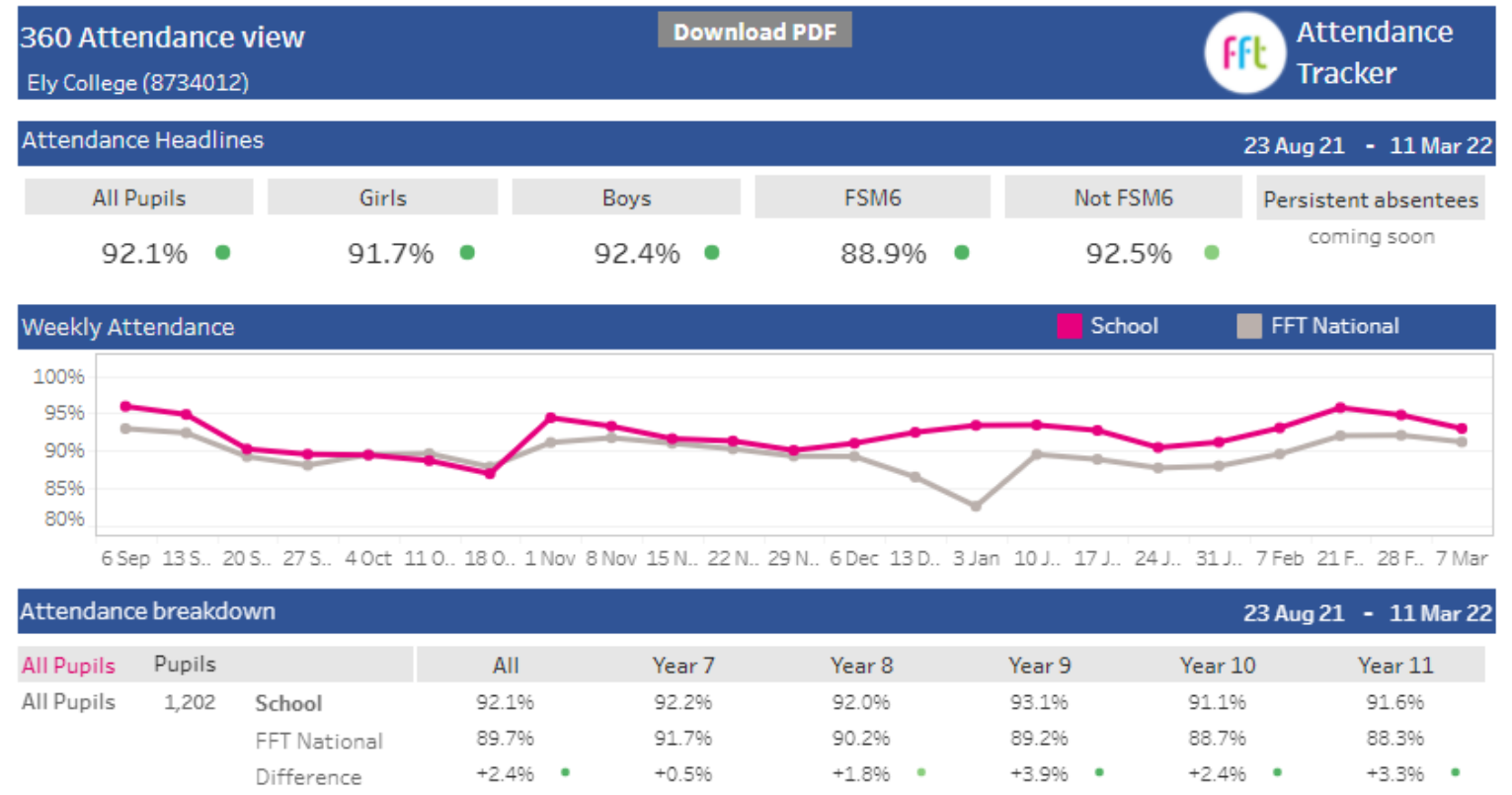

- Target is 96%



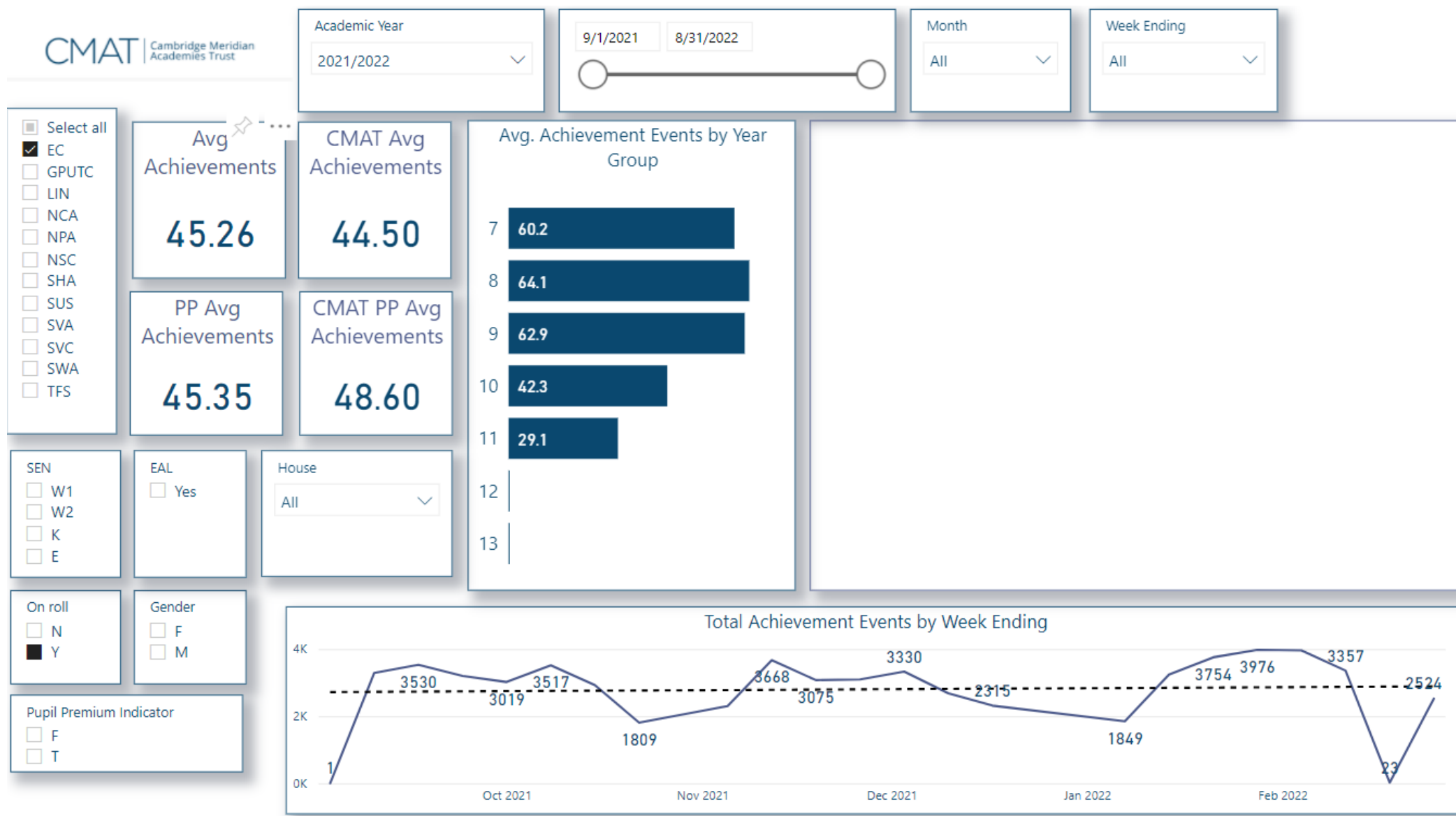

Key stats 7-13 March

- 249 cases in East Cambs  of 83%
- Vaccination rates in East Cambs
 - 78% of 12-15 (highest in region for first dose)
 - 46.2% of 12-15 (for second dose – second in region (South Cambs at 47.5%))
 - 85.5% of 16-17 for first dose – highest in region
 - 73.4% of 16-17 for second dose – highest in region
- PCR tests dropped since Jan but now increasing

Achievements



Behaviour

- CMAT average for BP is 7.9 – Ely is averaging 16.7*
- Majority of BP are issued in year 9 and 10
- Main reasons – disruption & non completion of homework
- Lateness in Year 10 and 11 a concern – will be continue to be a focus

Uniform infringements

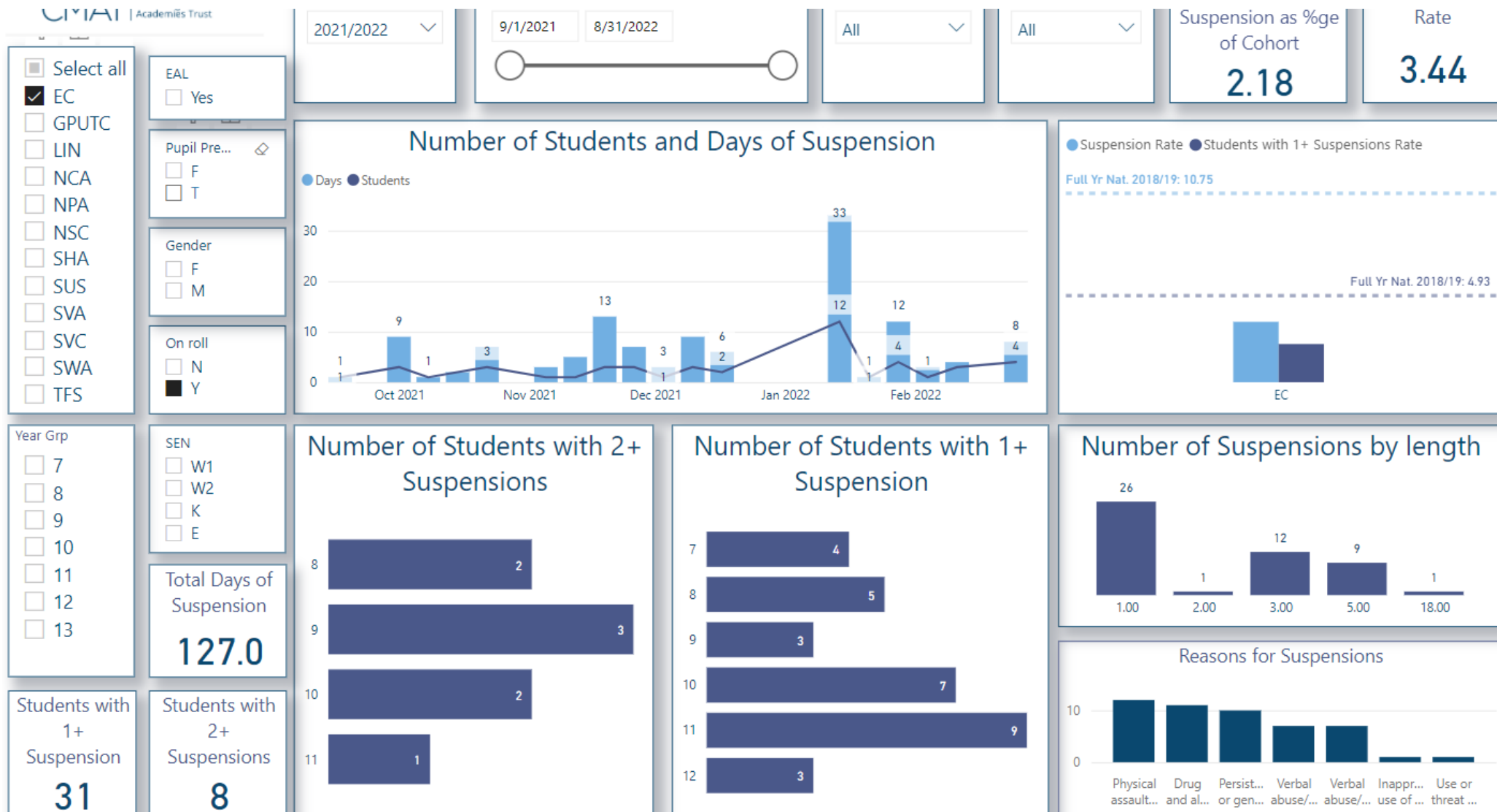
- 29 students out of 1200 have more than 5 BP for uniform issues
- Year 7 – 1
- Year 8 – 2
- Year 9 – 8
- Year 10 – 15
- Year 11 - 3

The average BP per student in the cohort is 16

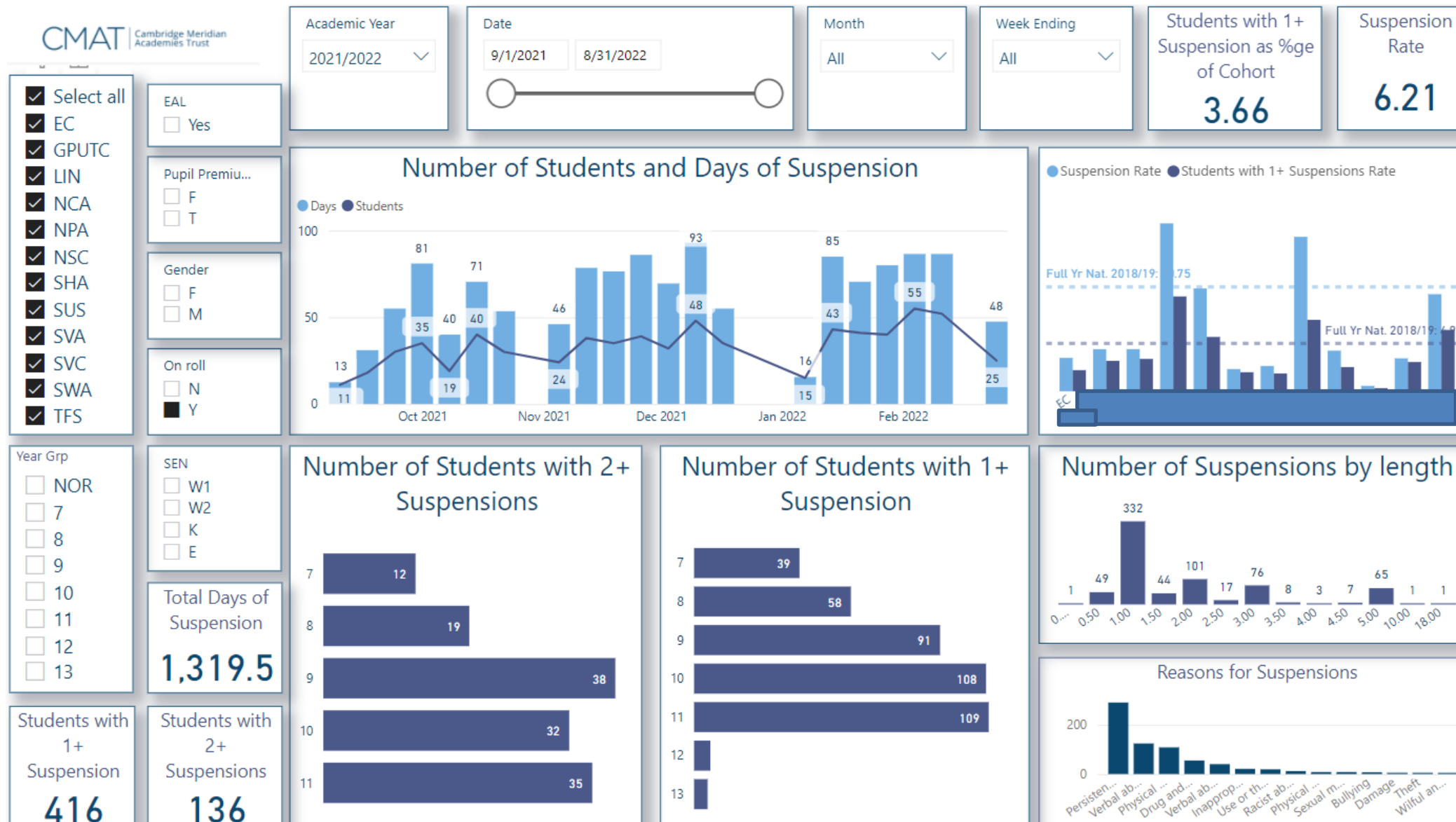
The average BP for these 29 students alone is 80

- CMAT has merged with CPET to create Meridian Trust with 28 schools educating approximately 17,000 students



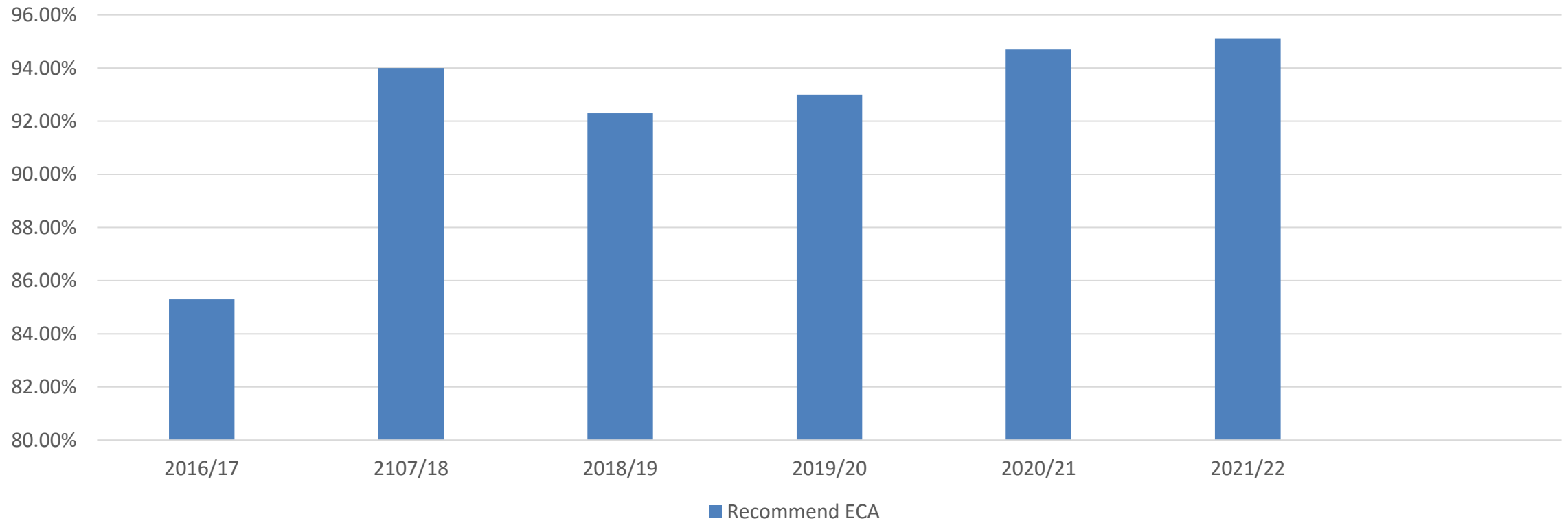
No longer solely Cambridge based
