### Year 11 Updates

We would like to invite you to the college on the evening on Monday 25<sup>th</sup> March at 6pm. The purpose of this evening will be to share ways in which you can support your child at home with revision and strategies on how to ease anxieties they may feel around exams. There will be a presentation from the core subjects – English, Mathematics and Science – where the key content shared in advance by the exam boards will be clearly set out. We will also provide an update on other Year 11 matters including the accepting of offers from post-16 centres and the collection of results in the Summer. This is an evening that will be useful to parents and students so we would encourage students to attend with you.

We are offering Year 11 students the chance to purchase a Leavers' Hoodie as a memento of their last year at Ely College. The design will have a personalised name across the front along with Ely College and on the back "2024" which will be made up of student's full names. Hoodies can be ordered in Navy, Grey or Black. The cost of a hoodie will be £23.20. I will have samples in my office that students are welcome to try on for size. The name on the front of the hoodie must be sensible and appropriate. Please enter the colour, size and required name on WisePay when paying for the hoodie. This should include capitals letters, lower case and gaps in wording as appropriate. Students will be able to wear the hoodies in college once they have been received. All other school uniform rules will continue to apply. If your son/daughter would like to order a hoodie, please make a payment online along with the details. The deadline for orders is 28<sup>th</sup> March. We are unable to accept late orders due to the printing schedule.

We would like to make you aware that Year 11 will have a year group photograph taken on Thursday 14<sup>th</sup> March. Each child will be photographed individually and then be superimposed onto a background. This keeps time out of lessons to a minimum. Details on how to purchase and the cost of the photograph will follow in due course. Usual school rules on makeup, jewellery and uniform apply! We hope that the photograph will be a great memory of students' time at Ely College to look back at in years to come.

Thursday 28<sup>th</sup> March is the last day of term and usual lessons will be suspended for a 'Year 11 Wellbeing Day' where students will be involved in a whole-group workshop in period 1 that will introduce the day's focus. In advance of the day, students will be able to select different events to be involved in during periods 2-5. We hope that it allows students to enjoy some new activities and consider how they can positively support their wellbeing. I can confirm it will be a non-uniform day for Year 11. Please ensure that clothing is appropriate for school and comfortable, especially if they choose to participate in a sporting activity, as we won't have access to changing rooms. We are really looking forward to a positive day with Year 11.

We are still intending to proceed with the Prom on 28<sup>th</sup> June and further details, including the purchase of tickets, will follow in due course.
