Prom tickets go on sale today via WisePay. The cost is £13.50 and includes a drink on arrival. The Prom takes place at The Maltings on Friday 28<sup>th</sup> June 2024 with arrivals from 7pm. Last entry is at 8pm, Prom awards will be announced at 9.45pm and the evening finishes at 11pm. Ely College has a fabulous history of celebrating in style on Prom night and we look forward to seeing lots of Year 11 at this occasion. Conduct in college has been superb. We expect this to continue, but should it not, we will be unable to allow your child entry to the Prom. Should your child not meet behaviour expectations on the evening of the Prom, you will be called and expected to collect your child.
