We would like to offer your child the opportunity to see larger scale production of the one of the UK's biggest producers. We will take a closer look at over 100 years of fascinating Cadbury packaging designs and work in small groups to create our own Cadbury wrapper! Plus get hands-on with real chocolate moulds from the Bournville Cadbury factory.

#### The plan for the day:

Coach to Cadbury's World leaving Ely College at 8.30am

Coach leaving Cadbury's World at 2.00pm

Coach returns to Ely College at 5.00pm

The timings may change due to traffic. If these times change, we will inform you.

Please bring lunch and drinks for the day. There will be time for us to sit and have lunch during our tour.

The trip will cost £28 per student. Although such contribution is voluntary, in reality we have no alternative source of funding. If sufficient contributions are not received to make the visit financially viable, then it will be cancelled and all contributions will be refunded. In cases of financial hardship, any requests for the contribution to be waived will be treated sympathetically; please contact the Principal in writing. If you qualify for Pupil Premium Grant support and are still in receipt of free school meals and would like to apply to access some of this funding towards this trip, then please tick the relevant box on the reply slip. As these are educational visits and are taking place in school hours, we are not permitted by law (Education Act 1996) to exclude from such a visit a student of parents choosing not to contribute to the cost.

We can accommodate a maximum of 74 students on this trip. This trip is only open to Catering students in Yrs 9, 10, 11, 12 and 13. If you would like your child to participate, please complete the 'Cadbury's World Trip - Expression of Interest' in WisePay by **Monday 30<sup>th</sup> September 2024**. After this date, 74 students will be selected at random. Unsuccessful students will be kept on a waiting list in the event of a withdrawal.

We will request payment once student selections have been made.
