Year 11 Post-16


I thought it might be useful for you to be aware of where Year 11 students should be with regards to their post-16 application. There have been three PSHE lessons and weekly reminders in Year 11 assemblies. Students should have completed their profile, favoured appropriate fulltime courses that they qualify for and written their Personal Statements. The PowerPoints for these lessons can be found by students in the PSHE Teams folder.

We will have a break from the application process for the next four weeks while we prepare for and sit the mock exams. However, if your child has not completed one of these three steps in lesson time, please can you encourage them to do so as there is just two weeks/one PSHE lesson between the end of the mock period and their application deadline of Friday 13th December.

There will be a lesson where they will be shown how to make the application, but this will not be possible if they haven't completed the profile, favoured appropriate fulltime courses and written their Personal Statement.

We will upload their next set of forecast grades at the end of December and form tutors will be writing references next half term. These are both part of the applications that will be submitted.
