Dear Parents and Carers,

First of all, well done to all the students for their efforts in preparing for the Maths mock exams and thank you for your support.

Our follow-up to their mock results focuses on areas for improvement, and we will utilise the fundamental features on SPARX to help students address any mistakes made during the mocks. The fix-up and revision tools on SPARX are specially designed algorithms that enable students to focus on the specific topics and errors they encountered in their Maths mocks. It is crucial that students use these tools for revision and homework to ensure they perform well in their Maths exams in May/June. Please encourage them to do this weekly.

Students will be set weekly Sparx Homework and need to complete this alongside using Sparx Fix-Up. This will help prepare them for the next set of mock exams straight after February half term. A revision list and further additional revision websites will be provided for these in January.

Finally, I wanted to let you know that the Maths department is running two Year 11 revision classes every week on Thursdays P6: 15:05 – 16:00 in room BG4 for GCSE Higher and BG3b for GCSE Foundation.
