## Break and Lunch offer

- Students can spend a maximum of £5 a day, providing that they have sufficient funds on their account.
- Students in receipt of Free School Meals can spend up to £1.50 at breakfast and up to £2.80 at break or lunch.



# FAQ

## **“How much can I spend each day?”**

It will depend on the funds you have on your account, but everyone has a £5 daily spending limit. If you receive free school meals, your account will automatically have the funds to spend up to £1.50 at breakfast and up to £2.80 across break and lunch.

## **“What if I don’t have enough money on my account?”**

It happens! The canteen staff will tell you if you don’t have enough on your account to purchase what you want. They may suggest cheaper alternatives, or you can go to your house office to see if your parents/carers are able to top up your account.

## **“Do I have to use the meal deals?”**

No, you can buy items individually, but the meal deals mean you get more for less.
