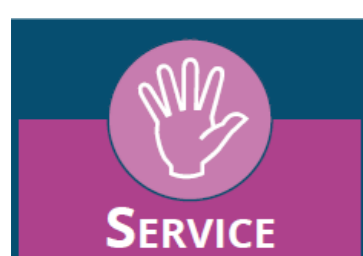
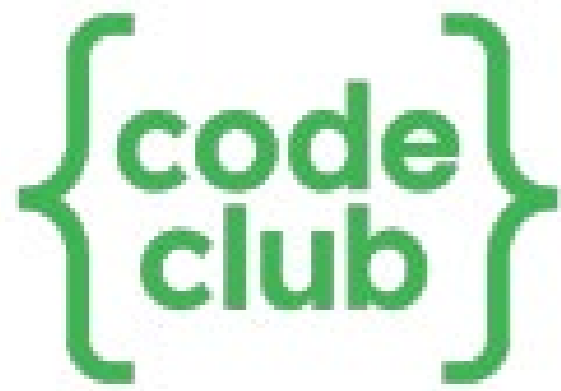

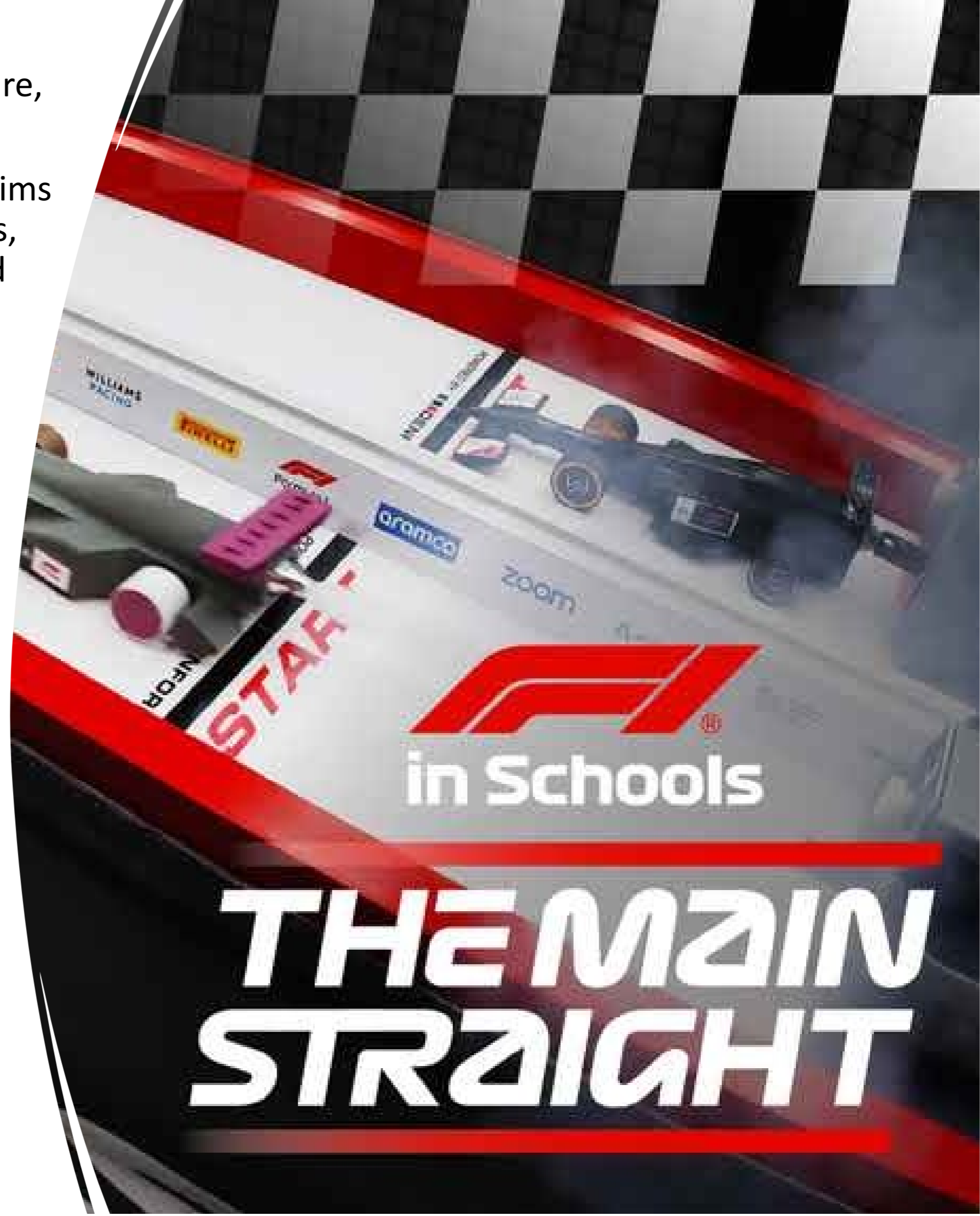
F1 in Schools is where students use CAD/CAM software to design, engineer, and race miniature, compressed-air-powered Formula 1 cars.

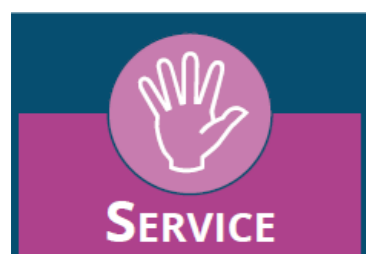

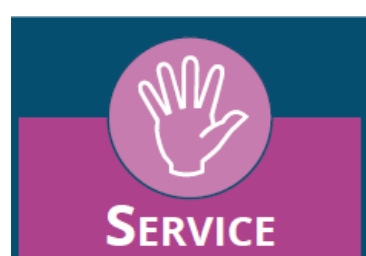
