The *Sparx Fix-up* feature provides personalised revision tasks based on questions students answered incorrectly in their recent mock examinations. Fix-up offers targeted practice through similar 'shadow' questions and short support videos to address misconceptions and close gaps in learning.

As this homework is tailored to each student's individual needs, it is important that all tasks are completed in full. Completing 100% of the Fix-up homework enables students to progress to more challenging material and make the best possible improvement.
