## Education Record App

The Department for Education has launched a new Education Record app for Year 11 students. The purpose of the app is:

- To allow students to have a digital record of exam results
- To allow students to share their results digitally with Post-16 centres
- To share information such as support required

On results day in August, students will be able to see their results on the app from 11am. You may wish to watch this short video for more information.

We will issue results in school on the day from 9am and all students will still be given physical copies of their exam results.

Students have seen this video in assembly and know that there are two stages to this process.

1. Students should download the app at home by searching for "Education Record" or follow the link here: [Education Record England App - App Store](#) or [Education Record England - Apps on Google Play](#) This should be done by Tuesday 5<sup>th</sup> May.
2. In school, House Offices will invite students individually to scan a QR code to link their results on our system to their app from Tuesday 5<sup>th</sup> May. Students will only need to have their phones out to scan the code and there will be members of staff to do this.
