## Year 10 History Mock Exams

With the Year 10 mocks approaching in June, the History Department will take measures to ensure we support your child as much as we can with their revision for their two Pearson/Edexcel GCSE History mock papers:

Paper 1 (Medicine) and a **partial**  
Paper 2 (Anglo-Saxon & Norman England ONLY).

From Monday 18<sup>th</sup> May, we will pause the teaching of our normal curriculum to carry out in-class revision which will last through the final week before half-term and the two weeks after it. This will give your child around 7-8 lessons of teacher-led revision in school to supplement the revision they will be doing at home.

In order to help keep our students organised, we strongly recommend that your child bring to their lessons over the next few weeks:

- Their Medicine exercise book from Year 9
- Any revision resources they may have made
- If possible, a notepad or something to write on. We can provide lined paper where needed but would like to limit this where possible.

I also wanted to remind you of the revision resources available to your child:

- The main place to start is our own Catchup & Revision Hub which your child can access via this link. It contains everything needed for your child to revise GCSE History and means you don't have to purchase other revision
